BYU Online High School

What do I need to do to graduate?

Upon acceptance into BYU Online High School, students meet with an Academic Advisor to develop a personalized graduation plan which includes choosing between our Standard Diploma Track and our Advanced Diploma Track. Graduation requirements include:

- Earn 24.0 course credits (48 courses).
- Complete a minimum of 6.0 credits (12 courses) through BYU Online High School; 3.0 credits (6 courses) of the 6.0 required may be split between the junior and senior year. Students must be enrolled in the semester in which they intend to graduate.
