Fence posts shall be a minimum of 4"x 4". All stringer elements shall be a minimum of 2"x 4" and consist of 3 stringers for every 6 linear feet of fencing. Picket style fencing shall have a minimum 5/8" thickness picket element.

Adjoining Fence Placement: Common property lines in any yard area shall have no more than one fence constructed between the two adjoining lots. If an applicant seeks to place a fence adjacent to an existing fence within 2 feet or less from the lot line, written approval from adjoining property owners is required. Should an adjoining property owner refuse to approve the proposed fence location, the fence must be at least 2 feet from the lot line.
